The new Pabay stamp (PS240) to be issued on 20 July 2009 depicts one of the “wild men” of Pabay waiting for a boat to take him to the mainland. The stamp has been designed by Louise Cunningham ([www.louisecunningham.co.uk](http://www.louisecunningham.co.uk)). The theme for this new stamp was inspired by the recent romantic Highland novel by Sue-Ellen Welfonder, *Bride for a Knight*. (ISBN-13 978-0-446-61730-7).
